Notes: The first six or seven columns are for comparison purposes. They show states where events were or are soon to be held, not those to whom first options were allocated.

Other events in clause 2 of the general by-law for ACF tournaments that have not been held in recent years have been omitted as before on the assumption that they will remain open for bids at any time.

Events that normally begin in one year and end in the next (such as the Australian Open and Australian Closed or National Championships) are distinguished by reference to the year in which they end because of the possibility that in some years they may be played entirely in that year. The Australian Schools Teams Championships are referred to by the school year in which the State qualifying events were held, even though the national finals might be held early in the following year, as occurred when the National Finals of the 2003 competition were held in Perth in January 2004.
