

ACF POLICY ON FIDE FEES

The payment of the various FIDE fees to be as follows:

1. Membership Fee

a. The ACF will pay.

2. Rating Fee

a. The ACF will pay FIDE rating fees for all ACF events that are allocated pursuant to ACF by-laws and that are to be FIDE-rated.

3. Entry Fees

a. The ACF will pay for Asian Teams.

b. The Olympiad Appeal will pay for Olympiad; an amount equal to the entry fee to be paid by the ACF to FIDE in respect of a selected player shall be paid to the ACF by or on behalf of that player before the player's name is forwarded to the competition organisers.

4. Registration and Rating fees for non-ACF Events Fees

a. Any fees charged in relation to the registration or rating of a FIDE-rated event held in Australia, other than an event to which Clause 2a applies, will be paid by the organisation that requests that it be rated.

b. In respect of such an event, the ACF will pay the fees when it is billed by FIDE and the tournament organisers will reimburse the ACF for the amount so paid, provided that the organisers shall pay to the ACF, on account, a reasonable estimate of the amount of the FIDE fees for the event within one month after the conclusion of the event".

5. Titles

a. The ACF will pay the fees for any GM and WGM titles.

b. The ACF will pay 50% of the fees for any IM and WIM titles.

c. The ACF shall not bear the cost of fees to be paid for FM or WFM titles.

d. The State Association in which the recipient resides will pay the fees for any IA titles.

e. The ACF shall not apply for any FIDE title unless the appropriate fee as listed in 5b, c and d has been received by the ACF.

6. Deposit Fees

a. The organisers of any event shall pay the appropriate deposit before the ACF bids for the event.

7. FIDE Documents

a. The ACF shall pay for any extra copies considered essential to the Federation.

8. Other FIDE Fees

a. Unless otherwise resolved, the Federation shall not bear the cost of any other FIDE fees or charges.
